Jacksonville, FL, January 29, 2007 – The Jacksonville Asian American Alliance (JAAA) is pleased to announce the **JAAA Scholarship Program** for high school senior students planning to pursue a traditional baccalaureate degree at an accredited four-year college or university in the U.S. this year.

In 2007, the program will award scholarships to three (3) high school seniors attending public school in Duval, Clay and St. Johns Counties. Asian and non-Asian students are eligible to apply. Successful applicants will be awarded \$500 each toward college costs.

To qualify, an applicant must: be a resident of Duval, Clay or St. Johns counties for at least a year; be enrolled in a public high school; be accepted at a four-year college or university; have a minimum GPA of 3.5; and have an outstanding record of community service.

To apply, eligible senior students must complete an application form available at www.jaxaaa.org/scholarship.program.php and submit an official school transcript, proof of admission to a college or university, and a letter of recommendation from a person who is familiar with the applicant's community service.
